### Present

<b>I</b>	grade
<b>you</b>	grade
<b>he/she/it</b>	grades
<b>we</b>	grade
<b>you</b>	grade
<b>they</b>	grade

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	graded
<b>you</b>	graded
<b>he/she/it</b>	graded
<b>we</b>	graded
<b>you</b>	graded
<b>they</b>	graded

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have graded
<b>you</b>	have graded
<b>he/she/it</b>	has graded
<b>we</b>	have graded
<b>you</b>	have graded
<b>they</b>	have graded

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had graded
<b>you</b>	had graded
<b>he/she/it</b>	had graded
<b>we</b>	had graded
<b>you</b>	had graded
<b>they</b>	had graded

### Future

<b>I</b>	will grade
<b>you</b>	will grade
<b>he/she/it</b>	will grade
<b>we</b>	will grade
<b>you</b>	will grade

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	will have graded
<b>you</b>	will have graded
<b>he/she/it</b>	will have graded
<b>we</b>	will have graded
<b>you</b>	will have graded
<b>they</b>	will have graded

## Conditional

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am grading
<b>you</b>	are grading
<b>he/she/it</b>	is grading
<b>we</b>	are grading
<b>you</b>	are grading
<b>they</b>	are grading

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was grading
<b>you</b>	were grading
<b>he/she/it</b>	was grading
<b>we</b>	were grading
<b>you</b>	were grading
<b>they</b>	were grading

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been grading
<b>you</b>	have been grading
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been grading
<b>we</b>	have been grading
<b>you</b>	have been grading
<b>they</b>	have been grading

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been grading
<b>you</b>	had been grading
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been grading
<b>we</b>	had been grading
<b>you</b>	had been grading
<b>they</b>	had been grading

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be grading
<b>you</b>	will be grading
<b>he/she/it</b>	will be grading
<b>we</b>	will be grading
