### Present

<b>I</b>	recognize
<b>you</b>	recognize
<b>he/she/it</b>	recognizes
<b>we</b>	recognize
<b>you</b>	recognize
<b>they</b>	recognize

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am recognizing
<b>you</b>	are recognizing
<b>he/she/it</b>	is recognizing
<b>we</b>	are recognizing
<b>you</b>	are recognizing
<b>they</b>	are recognizing

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	recognized
<b>you</b>	recognized
<b>he/she/it</b>	recognized
<b>we</b>	recognized
<b>you</b>	recognized
<b>they</b>	recognized

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was recognizing
<b>you</b>	were recognizing
<b>he/she/it</b>	was recognizing
<b>we</b>	were recognizing
<b>you</b>	were recognizing
<b>they</b>	were recognizing

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have recognized
<b>you</b>	have recognized
<b>he/she/it</b>	has recognized
<b>we</b>	have recognized
<b>you</b>	have recognized
<b>they</b>	have recognized

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been recognizing
<b>you</b>	have been recognizing
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been recognizing
<b>we</b>	have been recognizing
<b>you</b>	have been recognizing
<b>they</b>	have been recognizing

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had recognized
<b>you</b>	had recognized
<b>he/she/it</b>	had recognized
<b>we</b>	had recognized
<b>you</b>	had recognized
<b>they</b>	had recognized

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been recognizing
<b>you</b>	had been recognizing
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been recognizing

### Future

<b>I</b>	will recognize
<b>you</b>	will recognize
<b>he/she/it</b>	will recognize
<b>we</b>	will recognize

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be recognizing
<b>you</b>	will be recognizing
<b>he/she/it</b>	will be recognizing

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	will have recognized
<b>you</b>	will have recognized

### Conditional present

<b>I</b>	would recognize
<b>you</b>	would recognize
<b>he/she/it</b>	would recognize
<b>we</b>	would recognize
<b>you</b>	would recognize
<b>they</b>	would recognize

### Conditional perfect

<b>I</b>	would have recognized
<b>you</b>	would have recognized
<b>he/she/it</b>	would have recognized
<b>we</b>	would have recognized
<b>you</b>	would have recognized
<b>they</b>	would have recognized

## Subjunctive

### Present subjunctive

<b>I</b>	recognize
<b>you</b>	recognize
<b>he/she/it</b>	recognize
<b>we</b>	recognize

### Past perfect subjunctive

<b>I</b>	had recognized
<b>you</b>	had recognized
<b>he/she/it</b>	had recognized

### Conditional perfect progressive

<b>I</b>	would have been recognizing
<b>you</b>	would have been recognizing
